***Who is eligible?***

New Jersey high school graduates physician-diagnosed with ME/CFS.

***What is the purpose of the scholarship program?***

The purpose of the NJME/CFSA Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a deserving student who has ME/CFS and wishes to pursue his/her educational goals in college or technical school.

***What is the amount of the scholarship?***

The NJME/CFSA Scholarship is a single scholarship in the amount of **\$2,000** to be applied toward the student's tuition or educational related expense.

***What are the requirements?***

Applicants will be judged on their merit, sincerity of their essay, and their financial need.

Recognizing the cognitive difficulties associated with ME/CFS, less emphasis will be placed on academic achievements.
